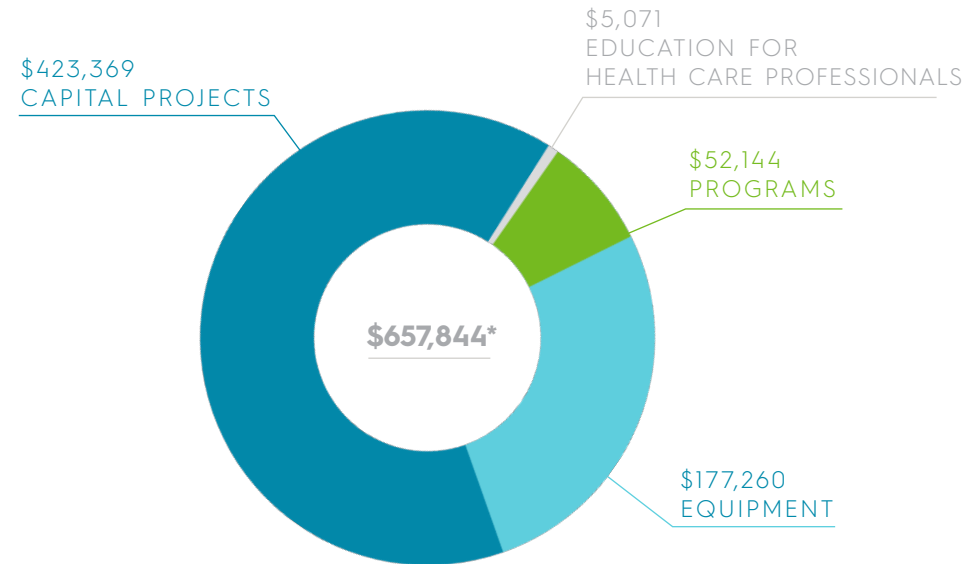

DOLLARS DISBURSED

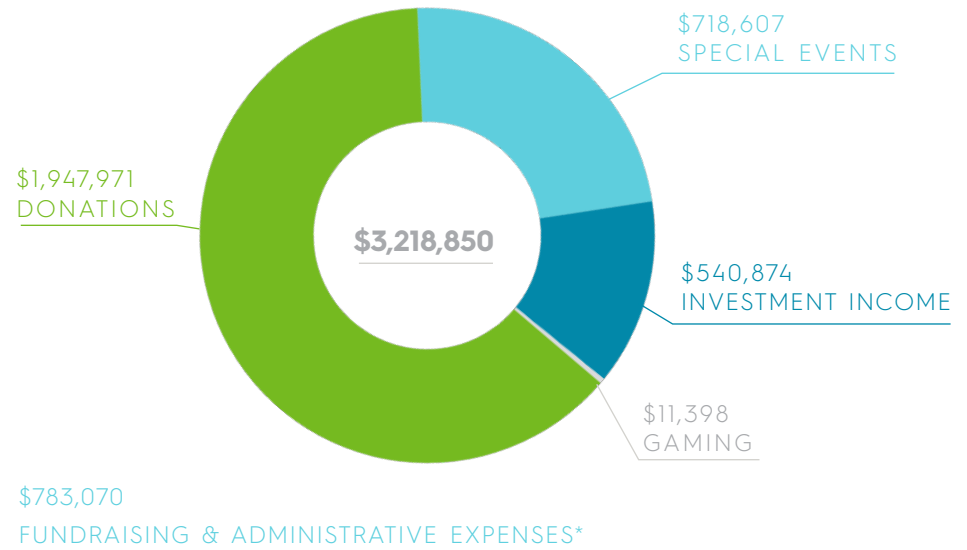
FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING MARCH 31, 2024

EQUIPMENT FUNDED

MAXBLEND 2 OPTIFLOW JUNIOR VENTILATOR

EMERGENCY & RESPIRATORY DEPARTMENTS

Delivers dedicated ventilation for pediatric or neonatal patients in emergency situations, or experiencing difficulty breathing on their own.

MOBILITY AIDS

HOME HEALTH PROGRAM

Sit to stand handles, leg rests for wound care, pedaller for patient comfort and mobility.

PLATELET AGITATOR

LAB

Provides advanced blood bank storage and preservation of platelets to be used for transfusion in instances of blood loss, surgery or medical conditions that affect blood or blood components.

PORTABLE ULTRASOUND MACHINE

EMERGENCY & MEDICAL IMAGING DEPARTMENTS

Provides real-time, bedside imaging for improved efficiency, patient comfort and safety.



PROGRAMS FUNDED

AREOLA TATTOO CLINIC

Funded entirely by ERH Foundation, and the only clinic of its kind in the Lower Mainland, offers free services to cancer survivors following mastectomy surgery, providing the final stage of closure.

HEARING FOR KIDS

Provides the gift of hearing to school-aged children in the Fraser Health Region, who face financial barriers, through Foundation funded hearing aids, batteries and fittings.

START PROGRAM: YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH

Short Term Assessment Response Treatment provides intervention for children and teens experiencing mental health crises by funding program supplies and activities which support improved socialization, confidence and self esteem.

THE LODGES: ADULT MENTAL HEALTH

The Hopes and Dreams Fund provides activities, experiences and physical spaces to support the residents of Cypress, Cottonwood and Connelly Lodges to foster coping mechanisms, promote social integration and reduce isolation.

WHATEVER IT TAKES: PATIENT SUPPORT

Funding assists patients with barriers preventing their return home, supports at-home recovery, preventing readmission to hospital.
