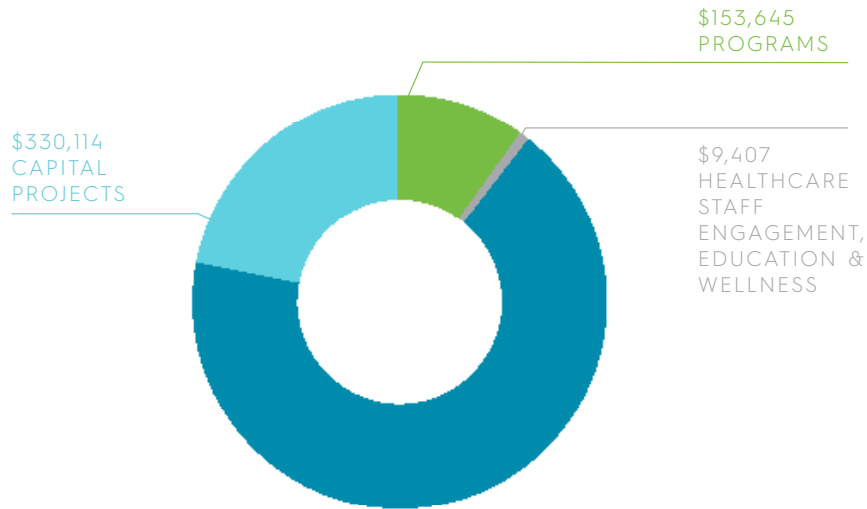

# DOLLARS DISBURSED

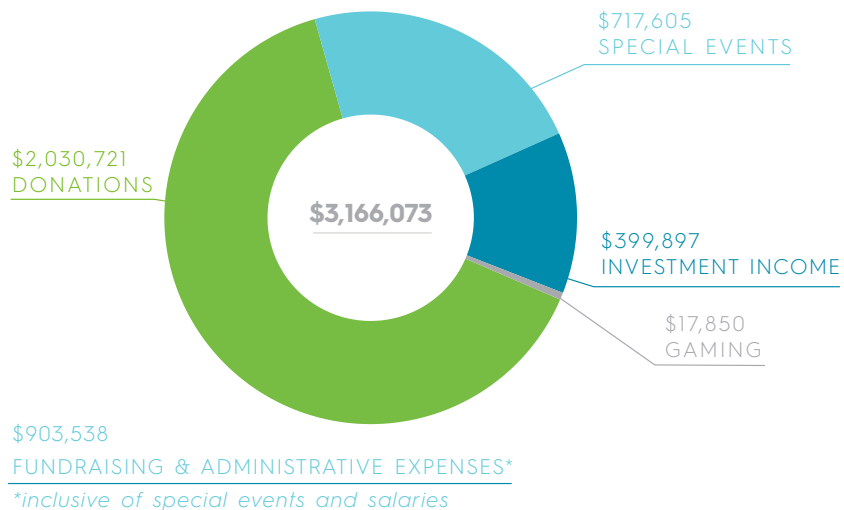
FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING MARCH 31, 2026

# YOUR DONATIONS AT WORK

## EQUIPMENT

Made possible by your support, this list below highlights some of the essential equipment funded this past year, putting vital tools into the hands of our health care teams.



### Bladder Scanner

Provides a comfortable, non-invasive way to check bladder function and guide care.



### Ultrasound

Enables real-time imaging to support accurate diagnosis and improve patient outcomes.



### VRI Translation System

Connects patients and care teams with interpreters in real time, ensuring clear and accessible communication.



### Ceiling Lift

Provides for safe patient transfers while protecting both patients and care teams.



### Portable Oximeter

A handheld device that measures blood oxygen levels and pulse rate quickly and non-invasively.



### Cardiac Echo

Delivers real-time cardiac imaging to support accurate diagnosis and care planning.



### Scan Stretcher

Supports efficient, safe patient transfers and positioning for diagnostic imaging.



### Transfer Device, Sara Stedy

Assists patients to move safely from sitting to standing while maintaining comfort and stability.



### Bluetooth Probe and Console

Real-time monitoring and data collection during procedures.



### Vein Viewer

Uses light technology to make veins visible, supporting faster and more accurate access.



### Surgical Microscope

Assists surgeons with complex procedures allowing greater precision and control.



### Bronchoscopy Suite

A specialized clinical space equipped for examination and procedures to treat the airways and lungs.

## PROGRAMS

Because of you, these vital community health programs were made possible.



### Areola Tattoo Clinic

Last year, 115 patients benefited from this donor-funded program—the only clinic of its kind in the Lower Mainland offering services at no charge to patients. Providing free care to breast cancer survivors following mastectomy surgery, it supports the final stage of recovery while helping restore confidence, dignity, and a sense of closure.



### Facial Aesthetic Medical Tattooing Clinic

In its first year, the Aesthetic Medical Tattooing Clinic served 34 patients who benefited from this donor-funded program at no cost. Our clinic is the only one in the Lower Mainland offering restorative care for individuals affected by facial resection surgery following skin cancer. The clinic helps rebuild confidence, dignity, and a sense of wholeness.

## Other community health programs supported last year:



### Hearing for Kids

The gift of hearing for school-aged children facing financial barriers to support learning, socialization and self-confidence.



### Youth Concurrent Disorders

Recreation Therapy to help reduce anxiety, depression, and stress, while fostering social connection, and coping skills to aid recovery.



### The Lodges (Adult Mental Health)

Supportive services emphasizing recovery, dignity, and community connection, to support greater independence, stability, and improved quality of life.
